What is the Uncontested Divorce Clinic?

A *pro bono* uncontested divorce is a divorce in which the parties agree to the divorce, and for which an LSNV client will not have to pay an attorney's fee. The client may, however, have to pay certain court costs.

What Documents do I Need?

If the client qualifies to participate, she or he will be given an appointment to participate in a clinic and given two documents to review prior to arriving for the appointment:

1. [Legal Services of Northern Virginia Divorce Intake Questionnaire](#), which must be

filled out to the best of the applicant's ability before the appointment.

2. *Pro Bono Uncontested Divorce Project Information Handout*, (**English**) (**Korean**) (**Spanish**) and (**Vietnamese**) that should be carefully read, because it tells the client many important things, for instance:
 - a. What documents the client should bring to the appointment.
 - b. What the Pro Bono Uncontested Divorce Project can and cannot do for the client.
 - c. What the client must do before the client's case can be referred to a *pro bono* (free) attorney for an uncontested divorce.
